 - o Certificate of Release or Discharge from Active Duty
 - o Statement of Service for transitioning service members still on active duty

- o Standard Form-15, Application for 10-point Veterans Preference, if applicable
- o Department of Veterans Affairs, Service-Connected Disability Award Letter
- College transcripts, if applicable

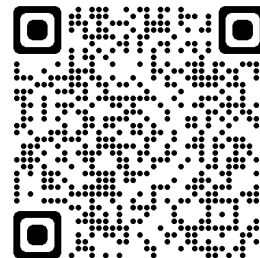
