The Technology Clearinghouse makes curated homeland security technology information available to improve decision making. This information can help decision makers in:

- Saving money, time, and lives with better access to innovative technology solutions

ONE PLATFORM

Known as Technology Clearinghouse 2.0, our recently updated platform allows for public and access-restricted content to be shared from a single platform. DHS users can access the site with their credentials to search and find information. Other members of the homeland security community can access all the public information. Each user's search results will be tailored to their own access permissions. We envision future



versions of the Technology Clearinghouse to expand restricted access to the broader federal government, then to state and local homeland security professionals, and eventually beyond.

SHARING FINDINGS

Currently, authorized DHS users can share findings and final results of their science and technology activities, extending the impact and longevity of their work by reaching more audiences. Technology Clearinghouse content includes:

- Research and development findings
- Testing and evaluation reports
- Technology scouting and market surveys
- Technology transition, transfer and commercialization artifacts
- Standards
- Lessons learned and best practices
