Issue: NPS Permit# 21-0278 – Women For America First

Program: WASO – Visitor and Resource Protection – United States Park Police

Key Points:

- The Women For America First will assemble on the Ellipse on January 6, 2021 for a First Amendment demonstration to protest the results of the 2020 elections.
- Expected attendance is around 5,000 participants.
- POTUS is expected to speak at the event at approximately 1100 hours.
- Previous similar First Amendment demonstrations have led to wide-spread violence in the downtown DC area.

Background:

On January 6, 2021, Congress will hold a joint session to formally certify the electoral votes from the 2020 election. It is expected that some members of Congress will object to the election results that the Biden-Harris ticket won the election. Numerous First Amendment demonstrations are expected in the downtown DC area to protest the results of this election. On November 14, 2020 and December 12, 2020, similar protests occurred. In both instances wide-spread violence occurred in the downtown DC area, perpetrated by both sides of the political spectrum.

NPS Impact

- NPS areas impacted will include President’s Park and the National Mall and Memorial Parks.
- NPS should expect higher than normal visitation with both pro and counter groups occupying NPS reservations.
- USPP, in coordination with the Metropolitan DC Police Department, will enact both no parking restrictions and road closures in the following areas on NPS jurisdiction:
 - Madison Drive between 3rd Street and 14th Street NW
 - Jefferson Drive between 3rd Street and 14th Street NW
 - Constitution Avenue between 15th Street and 18th Street NW
 - 15th Street between Independence Avenue SW and Constitution Avenue NW
 - 17th Street between Independence Avenue SW and Constitution Avenue NW

Intelligence

- Previous similar First Amendment demonstrations on NPS jurisdiction have led to violence in the downtown DC area. According to social media, both sides are preparing for violence to occur again.

The SITROOM brings together homeland security enterprise partners to improve our preparedness for possible civil unrest. Letter from the Mayor

Dear Washingtonians,

I want to start by saying thank you. Thank you to the 712,000 residents of Washington, DC for doing your part to keep our city safe. Today, we saw an affront on not only our American democracy, but our DC values — the values that make the District of Columbia a welcoming, diverse, and inclusive city. We step up daily to support our federal government and the many federal events and activities that take place in our hometown, to ensure safety in the nation’s capital, all despite having zero voting representation in the Congress that came under siege earlier today.

I also want to thank the women and men of the Metropolitan Police Department (MPD) who performed admirably – they made our city proud and nation proud. After weeks of planning, MPD immediately answered the call to support our federal partners without hesitation and quickly restored order to the Capitol.

This was an unprecedented attack on our democracy by the

United States President, and he must be held accountable. His constant divisive rhetoric led to the abhorrent actions we saw today, and sadly, the loss of life that will forever be a stain on what could have been and should have been a peaceful transfer of power. Again, he must be held accountable.

At this hour, we can report that the Capitol is secure, and MPD has worked in collaboration with the U.S. Capitol Police and Secretary of the Army to further secure the grounds for the upcoming days. According to our plan, this afternoon, I called for a curfew that began at 6:00 p.m. today, January 6 and will expire tomorrow morning, January 7, at 6:00 a.m. All essential and emergency personnel are exempt from the curfew, and the DC Government will open on time for normal operations on Thursday, January 7.

Additionally, I want to thank the lawmakers who returned to the Capitol tonight to do the work of the people in the People's House. And I want to thank our regional partners, including the Governors of Maryland and Virginia and the County Executives and Police Chiefs in the surrounding jurisdictions who responded to MPD's call for mutual support in the city and also the call from the U.S. Capitol Police for support at the Capitol.

This evening, I signed a Mayor's Order that extends the public emergency that I declared earlier today for 15 days so that we can ensure peace and security through the inauguration of President Joe Biden and Vice President Kamala Harris.

Today was a dark day for our democracy, but there is hope and change coming.

Once again, thank you, DC.

"What transpired yesterday was tragic and sickening. While I have consistently condemned political violence on both sides of the aisle, specifically violence directed at law enforcement, we now see some supporters of the President using violence as a means to achieve political ends. This is unacceptable. These violent actions are unconscionable, and I implore the President and all elected officials to strongly condemn the violence that took place yesterday.

DHS takes the safety and security of all Americans very seriously—it's at the core of our mission to defend our homeland. Any appearance of inciting violence by an elected official goes against who we are as Americans. Every American is guaranteed the right to peacefully protest, but once those protests become violent, we should enforce our laws and bring those responsible to justice—regardless of political motivations. After a challenging and saddening 2020, it's time for every American to respect each other and the rule of law in 2021.

I will remain in my position until the end of the Administration to ensure the Department's focus remains on the serious threats facing our country and an orderly transition to President-elect Biden's DHS team."
