SUBJECT: REVISION 1: Rescind Federal Acquisition Regulation Class

Deviation (Number 22-01) – Executive Order 14042 Ensuring Adequate COVID Safety Protocols for Federal Contractors

1. **Purpose:** This memorandum rescinds the class deviation in its entirety.

2. Background: On May 11, 2023 Supplement 1 was issued to *CAAC Letter 2021-03 Class Deviation From the Federal Acquisition Regulation (FAR) Regarding Implementation of Executive Order 14042, Ensuring Adequate COVID Safety Protocols for Federal Contractors to rescind 2021-03.* Supplement 1 is based on Executive Order 14099 entitled "Moving Beyond COVID-19 Vaccination Requirements for Federal Workers" that is effective at 12:01am on May 12, 2023, and revokes E.O. 14042.
