



Small Unmanned Aircraft Systems (sUAS)

The Department of Homeland Security (DHS) has three (3) Blanket Purchase Agreements (BPAs), which allow all DHS components to procure small Unmanned Aircraft Systems (sUAS), their accessories, and associated parts and services. sUAS are miniature aerial drones that operators can utilize to support a variety of missions such as airborne reconnaissance, aerial mapping, disaster response, Search and Rescue (S&R), and surveillance. These sUAS, which have been evaluated by DOD Defense Innovation Unit (DIU) under their Blue sUAS initiative to meet strict requirements, will provide users a wide range of new and dynamic tools for accomplishing the mission.

Key Contract Vehicle Features:

- The sUAS systems on these BPAs have been evaluated and approved by DOD Defense Innovation Unit (DIU), so they may be procured without requiring a waiver as per DHS Policy Memorandum 119-08 and the DHS sUAS Cybersecurity Guidance;
- BPAs were developed based on input from across the department through the DHS sUAS IPT and the Aviation Governance Board (AGB);
- These BPAs provide a one-stop solution for acquiring the approved sUAS systems, associated system components, training and maintenance;
- Improved pricing versus GSA MAS; and
- Option for bulk purchasing to allow even greater savings
