Medical Staffing Services

The Department of Homeland Security (DHS) established an Indefinite Delivery, Indefinite Quantity (IDIQ) for healthcare practitioners to provide medical care to maintain the health of individuals in the custody of DHS Components through an integrated health care delivery system. This contract vehicle provides for on-site medical staffing services with a continuum of health care services for residents/detainees 24 hours a day, seven (7) days per week, and 365 calendar days per year (24/7/365).

Key Contract Vehicle Features:

The Contractor shall furnish the necessary labor personnel and materials (travel, and ancillary labor) required to satisfy a full range of related requirements. The requirements include multiple key tasks:

- Front-line medical services, including the establishment, staffing, and operation of DHS locations, units, and facilities;
- Medical logistics support;
- Administration and program management;
- Reporting; and
- Coordination with local providers including medical support at locations, units, and facilities.

One 5-year base plus two, 2-year options (09/01/2023 – 08/31/2032)
