RECOGNIZE THE SIGNS OF SUSPICIOUS ACTIVITY

These could include someone:

- Entering a restricted area
- Testing security measures
- Having a prolonged or unusual interest in facilities, buildings, or infrastructure beyond casual or professional interest
- Collecting dangerous materials
- Making a spoken or written threat to harm people or facilities
- Attempting to disrupt or compromise an organization's information technology system

REMEMBER:

Factors such as race, ethnicity, gender, national origin, religion, sexual orientation, disability, or gender identity are **not suspicious**.
