



## Temporary Facilities and Services

The U.S. Department of Homeland Security (DHS) requires increased capability for the deployment and operation of scalable Temporary Facilities and Services in support of DHS mission critical efforts. These structures are intended to mitigate current and future crises, such as natural disasters, pandemics, and humanitarian issues in the United States and its territories. It is critical that temporary facilities, specifically constructed of material which can be efficiently and effectively built and taken down (demobilization). Structures and equipment will meet engineering standards such as structural, wind shear, electrical, Heating, Ventilation and Air Conditioning (HVAC), and lightning protection. Wrap around services and supplies include but are not limited to trash removal service, custodial services, water delivery, consumables, office supplies, document shredding service, food service, and security services.

Services include:

- Temporary Facilities Structure.;
- Infrastructure;
- Support Services; and
- Demobilization.

Key Contract Vehicle Features includes but is not limited to the contractor:

- Providing appropriate and proper facility layout in various configurations;
- Providing a firm and stable base for the deployment of the structures, ancillary equipment, access, and parking/maneuvering of all vehicles around site;
- Providing plumbing, and other infrastructure as required for adequate operation of the facility; and
- Contacting the appropriate local authorities to identify underground utilities before initiating any ground-disturbing activities.

One-year base, plus four one-year options (3/31/2021 – 3/30/2026)
