

# Are you a victim of **JAMMING?**

Disruption or failure of wireless communications, including cellular or GPS, for unknown reasons could be due to faulty equipment, physical obstructions, lawful devices using the same frequencies, or **could indicate the operation of a jammer.**

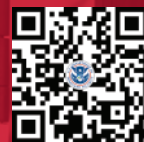
