OASIS+

The Department of Homeland Security (DHS) adopted One Acquisition Solution for Integrated Services+ (OASIS+) contracts as a Strategic Sourcing Vehicle (SSV). OASIS+ is a suite of six governmentwide, multi-award IDIQ contracts encompassing OASIS+ Total Small Business, OASIS+ HUBZone, OASIS+ SDVOSB, OASIS+ WOSB, OASIS+ 8(a) and OASIS+ Unrestricted (UR) contracts to procure non-IT commercial or non-commercial services. OASIS+ is a government-wide Best-in-Class, multiple-award, Indefinite Delivery/Indefinite Quantity (IDIQ) contract program that provides mission support professional services across many areas of expertise and disciplines. OASIS+ Phase #1 Contains (8) Domains:

- Management and Advisory Services (8 NAICS codes)
- Research and Development Services (16 NAICS codes)
- Technical and Engineering Services (16 NAICS codes);
- Logistics Services (19 NAICS codes)
- Facilities Services (29 NAICS codes)
- Intelligence Services (16 NAICS codes)
- Environmental Services (11 NAICS codes)
- Enterprises Solutions (17 NAICS codes)

Key Contract Features:

- Provides a broad and comprehensive range of support services;
- Offers a large pool of vetted contractors giving DHS access to industry expertise;
- Promotes and supports DHS socioeconomic and Category Management goals;
- Allows flexibility for all contract types, including hybrids and cost-reimbursement, at the task order level;
- No contract dollar ceiling and No cap on awards;
- Open contract with continuous on-ramping; and
- Flat Contract Access Fee (CAF) rate of 0.15%.

Period of Performance (POP): OASIS+ contracts were awarded in 2024 with a 10-year ordering period (five-year base and five- year option period). Notwithstanding contractors that may have been awarded contracts on different dates, through on-ramps and award batches, all contractors for each contract family have the same contract end dates.
