The U.S. Customs and Border Protection, Office of Field Operations (OFO) has a requirement for eleven (11) Non-Intrusive Inspection (NII) Mobile X-Ray Vans.

CBP intends to acquire these units by placing the FY22 Delivery Order under the IDIQ# 70B03C21D00000041 awarded to Smiths Detection on 09/28/2021.

The U.S. Customs and Border Protection (CBP) requires Dual View (Side and Top views) Mobile X-Ray Vans to provide CBP officers with a mobile x-ray capability to conduct Non-Intrusive Inspections (NII) of passenger baggage and parcels at U.S. land, air, and seaports of entry (POEs). The officers' mission is to prevent the illegal entry of drugs, currency, weapons, and agricultural products into the United States while facilitating the flow of legitimate travel and trade. This Statement of Work (SOW) defines the tasks necessary to provide Mobile X-Ray Inspection Vans to include equipment, installation, testing, verification, documentation, logistics requirements, warranties, and maintenance required to allow CBP to sustain the operational capability of the equipment.

The NII Mobile X-Ray Vans shall be delivered to CBP Integrated Logistics Division, 10720 Richmond Highway, Suite N, Lorton, VA 22079 to be delivered by 7/30/2022.
