1.0 GENERAL

1.1 BACKGROUND

Under the EIS contract we are transitioning all CGONE data, Rescue 21 (R21), R21 Western Rivers (WR), Remote Fixed Facilities (RFF) and Vessel Traffic Service (VTS) circuits from a Verizon to AT&T service provider. Additionally, network service providers are moving away from Time Division Multiplexing (TDM) terrestrial services such as trunk (T1) and digital signal (DS3). which has been supported by copper cables. Newer technology to provide higher speeds and Bandwidth are being provided of fiber optic cable.

1.2 SCOPE

This scope funds application fees to American Tower Corporation (ATC) for reviewing site specific permits and related documents of leased property. The various sites are Government owned facilities, with ATC owned towers leased to the Government on these sites.

Each permit review cost \$500.00 per site. C5ISC-TSB-USD-DAR and Rescue 21 Product Line anticipate 30 sites in calendar year 2024.

1.3 OBJECTIVE

The reviewing of site-specific permits and related documents of leased property is essential if it is determined that any Special Construction of new conduit cable runs and/or disturbing of soil is required to get new service facilities such as fiber optic cable to the CG RFF huts to provide continued network connectivity. ATC will be reviewing construction plans being performed by other contractors on other contracts.

ATC provided Backhaul Application is required for each site.

This fee is for the American Tower Corporation property manager to review submitted proposed construction drawings to ensure there is no overlap with existing infrastructure and provide written approval or directive correction as needed. Approval is required to initiate any construction work on the leased property.
