Summary:

The recreational boating safety community has a responsibility and obligation to provide inclusive outreach, programming, training, and opportunity to the Black community. The National Safe Boating Council (NSBC) will lead a pilot campaign – Uniting the Black Community with Recreational Boating – to invite, educate, train, and provide a safe, welcoming boating experience for the Black community, which will lead to a more unified and diverse recreational boating community.

The NSBC will partner with representative organizations in support of the grant's goal to lead a pilot campaign – Uniting the Black Community with Recreational Boating.

At the heart of the ambitious goal of connecting the Black community to recreational boating is collaboration. Prominent NSBC partners, including US Sailing, the American Canoe Association, and Carefree Boat Clubs, have made a commitment to join a coalition in changing the landscape of recreational boating to be inclusive of the Black community. This support will be instrumental in pairing local partner organizations to complete the network infrastructure necessary to ally the Black community to recreational boating.
