**STATEMENT OF WORK (SOW) dated 10/10/2024**  
**Requirement: Used/Junk Car Training Requirement**  
**RFQ 70CMSW25Q00000001**

**Background:**

The Department of Homeland Security (DHS)/Immigration Customs Enforcement (ICE) is the largest federal law enforcement agency whose missions include preventing terrorism and enhancing security, managing our borders, administering immigration and customs laws, and securing cyberspace. A significant part of ICE's mission is providing required training tools and equipment to support OFTP law enforcement training courses held at Fort Moore, GA (more specifically, Fiske Range).

**Scope of Work:**

The scope of this requirement is to have a single contractor provide used/junk automobile vehicles which will be utilized in various dynamic law enforcement training courses at Fort Moore, GA. All vehicles and services are outlined in the Statement of Work (SOW) dated 10/10/24.

**Critical Measures of Success:**

Contractor shall provide used/junk vehicles that meet the following criteria below:

1. Shall be a 4-door sedan.
2. All doors and window glass must be intact and in the up/closed position.
3. All four tires must be inflated and have the ability to hold air (no punctured tires will be accepted).
4. Vehicles shall be clean and dry inside (no water damage or excessive dampness).
5. No wet seats, mold, trash, or foreign object inside the passenger compartment. Vehicles should not have dangerous holes or sharp metal areas that will injure personnel. Law enforcement agents will need to sit in the cars as part of the law enforcement arrest training operations.
6. The vehicles do not have to run and any color is acceptable.
7. Lights and safety equipment do not need to work.
8. The vehicles will be damaged, and the windows will be broken at the end of the training.
9. Contractor must be able to provide a MAXIMUM of 200 used/junk cars per 12-month period for entire 5-year POP of the Purchase Order.

**Delivery Schedule for used/junk cars:**

All delivery/pickup schedules will be coordinated with the OFTP COR identified on the award. OFTP anticipates that vehicles will need to be dropped off and picked up Monday – Friday between 8:00AM and 4:00PM eastern standard time. In addition, vehicles will need to be removed once training courses has been completed. The average law enforcement training class will require roughly 10 used/junk vehicles and an estimated 18-20 classes per 12-month period.
