This one-day event will include a tabletop exercise on preparing participants to respond to a campus emergency. The focus of this regional event will be a **soft target incident**, specifically **campus unrest caused by a controversial speaker**.

The event seeks to provide participants with insight into planning, preparedness and resilience best practices for the academic community. Because emergency planning involves a team of individuals from across an institution, it is recommended that up to 5-7 senior leaders representing various functions (i.e. leadership, public safety, student life, and communications) attend from each school.
