



.223 Remington Duty Ammunition

The Department of Homeland Security has approximately 72,000, armed agents and officers who are required by policy to qualify with various firearms on a regular basis. This contract is a re-competed strategic sourcing vehicle that was tremendously successful by providing the Department quality ammunition while achieving significant cost savings. Several DHS Components have weapons that are chambered to accept the .223 Remington round and have a substantial need for this ammunition in the performance of their duties.

Key Contract Vehicle Features:

- .223 Remington will be manufactured to a unified standard that will be validated by testing during source selection along with continued lot testing to ensure that the quality of the ammunition remains consistent over the life of the contract;
- By consolidating purchasing power across the Department, DHS will achieve significant cost savings per round comparative to current commercial premium law enforcement ammunition prices; and
- Eliminates the need for each Component to develop their own contract vehicle, will simplify the acquisition process, and facilitate acquisition efficiency across DHS.

Period of Performance (POP):

One-year base period with four one-year options:

- 8/2/2018 through 8/1/2023 if all options are exercised.
- Delivery dates up to twelve months past the end of the POP.
