



9mm Duty 124 Grain Ammunition

The Department of Homeland Security has approximately 72,000, armed agents and officers who are required by policy to qualify with various firearms on a regular basis. Recently, select DHS Components have switched to the 9mm handgun platform as part of their weapons refresh and modernization and have a need for 9mm duty ammunition. Additionally, there are several other federal agencies with officers / agents that may have a need for 9mm duty ammunition; therefore, this contract vehicle was designated as a Multi-Agency Contract (MAC).

Key Contract Vehicle Features:

- 9mm Duty 124 Grain ammunition will be manufactured to a unified standard that will be validated by testing during source selection along with random testing determined by ICE Office of Firearms and Tactical Programs (OFTP) after award;
- Components and other federal agencies will realize a significant cost savings by leveraging collective spend across multiple agencies; and,
- Eliminates the need for each program to develop their own contract vehicle, will simplify the acquisition process, and facilitate acquisition efficiency across federal agencies.

Period of Performance (POP):

One-year base period with four one-year options:

- 9/27/2017 through 9/26/2022 if all options are exercised.
- Delivery dates up to twelve months past the end of the POP.
