



## 9mm Readily Identifiable Training Ammunition (RITA)

The Department of Homeland Security has approximately 72,000, armed agents and officers who are required by policy to qualify with various firearms on a regular basis. Recently, Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE) switched to the 9mm handgun platform as part of their weapons refresh and modernization and have a need for Readily Identifiable Training Ammunition (RITA).

### Key Contract Vehicle Features:

- 9mm RITA will be manufactured to a unified standard that will be validated by testing during source selection along with random testing determined by ICE Office of Firearms and Tactical Programs (OFTP) after award;
- Components will realize a significant cost savings by using RITA for training purposes due to the price difference between duty and training ammunition; and,
- Eliminates the need for each Component to develop their own contract vehicle, will simplify the acquisition process, and facilitate acquisition efficiency across DHS.

### Period of Performance (POP):

One-year base period with four one-year options:

- 9/26/2018 through 9/25/2023 if all options are exercised.
- Delivery dates up to twelve months past the end of the POP.
