



Content Delivery Network

The Department of Homeland Security (DHS) awarded a Blanket Purchase Agreement (BPA) to provide Content Delivery Network (CDN) services to support current and future public-facing DHS websites, applications, and existing web portals. This BPA provides CDN services for DHS websites via a globally deployed server network.

Key Contract Vehicle Features:

- Maximizes performance objectives by accommodating unpredictable load increases (flash crowds) and Internet-wide projected growth.
- Monitors the public facing websites at the DHS Headquarters level to ensure security in order to reduce the risk of downtime, fend off denial-of-service attacks, and increase data security;
- Provides an average cost avoidance of at least 50 percent below the prior BPA; and
- Ensures performance is consistent across DHS' websites by preventing attacks and optimizing web traffic.
