



Continuous Diagnostics and Mitigation (CDM)

The Department of Homeland Security (DHS) adopted the General Services Administration (GSA) Federal Systems Integration and Management Center (FEDSIM) contract for the Continuous Diagnostics and Mitigation (CDM) program. The CDM multi-award, Schedule 70 Blanket Purchase Agreement (BPA) includes 17 vendors for tools and services to strengthen the cybersecurity posture of the federal civilian “.gov” networks.

Key Contract Vehicle Features:

- Provides government programs with specialized Information Technology (IT) tools and Continuous Monitoring as a Service (CMaaS) to enhance cyber-security efforts;
- Provides Department-wide efficiency through consolidation of evolving cyber security technologies; and
- Consolidates the collective volume for CDM and provides cost savings through tiered price discounts and negotiated task order discounts.

Period of Performance (POP):

One-year base, plus four one-year options (8/12/2013 - 8/11/2018)

Seventeen (13 large businesses and four small businesses)
