Department of Homeland Security Executive Fleet Vehicle Listing 2013 Reporting Year

In accordance with the Presidential Memorandum issued on May 24, 2011 on Federal Fleet Performance and GSA's Bulletin FMR B-32, Federal agencies are required to post on their website, any Executive Fleet Vehicles that are larger than midsize sedans or are not alternative fuel vehicles. The posting must be accessible to the public and searchable using the words "Executive Fleet Vehicles".

The Presidential Memo further states that pursuant to motor vehicle management regulations set forth at 41 C.F.R. 102-34.50, executive fleets are required to achieve maximum fuel efficiency; be limited in motor vehicle body size, engine size, and optional equipment to what is essential to meet the agency's mission.

As a result, the U.S. Department of Homeland Security has identified the following executive fleet vehicles that are categorized as such. This represents .2% of the DHS Fleet Program.
