



FSSI Wireless

The Department of Homeland Security (DHS) adopted the Federal Strategic Sourcing Initiative (FSSI) Wireless Blanket Purchase Agreement (BPA) developed by the General Services Administration (GSA). GSA established the Wireless FSSI program to improve the management of wireless contracts across the government. The FSSI Wireless program drives lower purchase and operational life-cycle costs for wireless services, while enabling improved management of mobile technology.

Key Contract Vehicle Features:

- Allows devices purchased outside the program to use the BPA plans and services;
- Offers selection of no-charge devices, with device refresh at 20 months;
- Consolidates multiple wireless services, plans, and devices across the enterprise into a streamlined program;
- Includes data collection and analysis of wireless device usage;
- Reduces total cost of ownership by saving up to 30 percent through volume-pricing and price-maintenance controls;
- Facilitates innovation needs in wireless device management with shared best practices and access to new technology;
- Provides multiple wireless carriers, devices, service plans, and device management support; and
- Improves management practices by allowing agencies to invest in mobile applications that deliver services more effectively and efficiently.

Period of Performance (POP):

One-year base, plus four one-year options (5/22/2013 - 5/21/2018). The ordering period has been extended six months to November 20, 2018. Task orders may extend five years beyond the expiration date, through November 2023.
