



GSA Fleet for Vehicle Leasing

The Department of Homeland Security (DHS) adopted the General Services Administration (GSA) Fleet for Vehicle Leasing contract vehicle, a Best-In-Class (BIC) solution as designated by the Office of Management and Budget (OMB), for full service long-term (120 continuous days or more) leasing of standard vehicles, such as:

- Sedan;
- Buses and ambulances;
- Light, medium, and heavy trucks; and
- Passenger vans.

Key Contract Vehicle Features:

- Provides customers with vehicle management support for the vehicle life cycle, including vehicle acquisitions and disposal, maintenance control and accident management, fuel and loss preventions services, and fleet management systems;
- Includes a modern fleet of 200,000+ vehicles that comply with all GSA Fleet lease policies regarding use, maintenance, and management of vehicles;
- Offers a web-based suite of online tools that provides inventory reports, monthly cost data, maintenance and upfit charges in order to track and determine the total cost of a lease;
- Includes administrative support from a national network of FMCs staffed by GSA managers and Fleet Service Representatives (FSRs) who are accustomed to providing support in their respective geographic areas;
- Includes a fleet card with each leased vehicle to purchase fuel and minor maintenance;
- Includes a network of technicians who provide preventive maintenance, repair, and accident management services through the National Maintenance Control Center (MCC) and the National Accident Management Center (AMC); and
- Offers an all-inclusive rate (structured by vehicle type) based on a monthly lease and mileage charge, which includes all maintenance and fuel expenses.
