

## MANAGING YOUR RESOURCES

- ▶ Create a deployable list of mission-ready packages
- ▶ Complete administrative paperwork for processing prior to events
- ▶ Ease burden at local level by identifying community needs before entering zone

## PREPARING FOR DISASTERS

- ▶ Hold regular cross-border exercises (TTX, full-scale, etc.) on mutual aid
- ▶ Train new and seasoned employees in EMAC 101; encourage training for decision makers across agencies
- ▶ Share plans and prepare for a variety of disasters

## INCREASING AWARENESS IN DISASTER SITUATIONS

- ▶ Provide decision makers with frequent situational updates
- ▶ Align SWICs with ESF 2 Leads
- ▶ Reduce geographic interference by sharing situational awareness reports across borders of dense population

## BUILDING UP CAPACITY

- ▶ Adopt a national model for deployable communications units
- ▶ Populate predetermined teams with specialized personnel and equipment
- ▶ Integrate private industry partners into disaster planning and response
- ▶ Seek guidance from all levels of government
