Mr. Paul L. Sagan has served on the Akamai board of directors since 2005 and served as executive vice chairman from 2013 to 2015. He was chief executive officer (CEO) of the company from 2005 through 2013, and president from 1999 until 2010, and again from 2011 until 2013. Mr. Sagan is currently an executive in residence at General Catalyst Partners, a venture capital firm based in Cambridge, Massachusetts, and Palo Alto, California. Prior to joining Akamai, Mr. Sagan was a senior advisor to the World Economic Forum, where he provided consultative services on IT issues. He previously held the positions of president and editor of new media at Time, Inc., and managing editor of Time Warner's News on Demand project. He founded both Road Runner, the world's first broadband cable modem service, and Pathfinder, one of the early Web properties that pioneered Internet advertising. Mr. Sagan is currently a director of EMC Corporation and VMware, Inc., and serves as non-executive chairman of Datto, Inc., and L2, Inc. Mr. Sagan is also a member of the Visiting Committee of the Massachusetts Institute of Technology's Department of Electrical Engineering and Computer Science and a director of ProPublica. Mr. Sagan holds a bachelor's degree in journalism from Northwestern University.
