Mr. John T. Stankey is the chief executive officer (CEO) of AT&T Entertainment and Internet Services at AT&T, where he is responsible for leading strategy, marketing and operations for the company's entertainment offerings, as well as its telecommunications and video operations in Mexico and Latin America. Previously at AT&T, Mr. Stankey served as group president of home solutions and chief strategy officer. Prior to this role he was president and CEO of AT&T Business Solutions, where he was responsible for serving AT&T's business customers worldwide and led AT&T's network operations organization, including AT&T Labs, engineering, capital planning, IT, and corporate shared services. Mr. Stankey has served in a number of other roles at AT&T, including president and CEO of AT&T Operations, Inc.; group president for telecom operations; chief technology officer; chief information officer; president and CEO of AT&T's Southwest region; and, president of industry markets. Before joining AT&T, Mr. Stankey held several leadership positions with SBC Southwest, including company president, CEO, and president of business communications services. He began his career in telecommunications with Pacific Bell in 1985, holding various positions in network operations, IT, video operations, engineering, corporate support, and sales and service. He is also a member of the Board of Visitors at the Anderson Graduate School of Management at the University of California, Los Angeles (UCLA), and serves on the boards of directors of UPS and the Cotton Bowl Athletic Association. Mr. Stankey earned a bachelor's degree in finance from Loyola Marymount University in Los Angeles in 1985 and a master's degree in business administration from UCLA in 1991.
