Before joining AT&T, Mr. Stankey held several leadership positions with SBC Southwest, including company president and CEO and president of its business communications services. He began his career in telecommunications with Pacific Bell in 1985, holding various positions in network operations, information technology, video operations, engineering, corporate support and sales and service.
