Ms. Maggie Wilderotter was named chairman and CEO of Frontier Communications in 2006. She joined the company in 2004 as president, CEO, and a member of the board of directors. From 2002 to 2004, she served as senior vice president of Worldwide Public Sector at Microsoft. She also served as executive vice president of national operations for AT&T Wireless Services, Inc.; CEO of AT&T's aviation communications division; and a senior vice president of McCaw Cellular Communications. Ms. Wilderotter serves on the boards of Xerox Corporation and Procter & Gamble Company.



From 2009 through 2013, FORTUNE magazine ranked her among the “50 Most Powerful Women in Business.” In December 2012, Ms. Wilderotter was named a member of the Executive Committee of the Business Roundtable, an association of chief executive officers of leading U.S. companies. In May 2014, Ms. Wilderotter became co-chair of The Committee for Economic Development, a nonprofit, nonpartisan, business-led, public policy organization. Ms. Wilderotter holds a bachelor's degree in economics from Holy Cross College. She was awarded an honorary doctor of engineering degree from the Stevens Institute of Technology.
