This is to request that, in accordance with paragraph 4 of Rule XXVII of the Standing Rules of the Senate, Mr. Lee Francis Cissna be approved to extend his detail to the U.S. Senate Committee on the Judiciary [Full Committee - Senator Grassley] from the U.S. Department of Homeland Security, Office of Policy, from August 20, 2016 through August 18, 2017.
