



## Vehicle Purchasing (AutoChoice)

The Department of Homeland Security (DHS) adopted the General Services Administration (GSA) Vehicle Purchasing (AutoChoice) contract vehicle, a Best-In-Class (BIC) solution as designated by the Office of Management and Budget (OMB), for purchases of new non-tactical vehicles. GSA is the mandatory source for federal executive agencies procuring these vehicles per Federal Property Management Regulations (FPMR), [Federal Property Management Regulations](#)

All vehicle purchases should be placed in and processed through GSA's AutoChoice system, an online ordering tool that offers an array of deeply-discounted vehicle solutions to meet an agency's automotive needs.

### Key Contract Vehicle Features:

- Includes a wide variety of vehicle types, including buses, SUVs, pickup trucks, vans, sedans, station wagons, wheelchair vehicles, ambulances, etc.;
- Meets Federal Vehicle Standards developed by GSA to ensure vehicles purchased are safe, durable, and economical, and provide uniformity in the acquisition process;
- Provides an online ordering system that enables users to compare vehicle options and prices, Greenhouse Gas (GHG) standards, miles per gallon, and other vehicle features; and
- Provides professional engineering services including technical assistance and vehicle design services for vehicles that are unique, required specialized purchase description, or not available on AutoChoice.

### Period of Performance (POP):

In effect until the termination of individual purchasing agreements by DHS issuing Components.
