Bulk Fuels/Direct Delivery Fuels

The Department of Homeland Security (DHS) has a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) with the Defense Logistics Agency - Energy (DLA-E) to purchase commercial fuels. This MOA is part of the Direct Delivery Fuels (DDF) Best-In-Class (BIC) solution established for use by all federal agencies by the Office of Management and Budget (OMB). The DDF includes procurement of the following types of fuel:

- Commercial aviation fuel;
- Commercial ship propulsion fuels; and
- Commercial ground fuels (diesel, gasoline, and "green" products).

DDF also supports short-notice provisioning of fuel for humanitarian relief efforts and worldwide contingency operations. The DHS Bulk Fuel MOA also allows for the procurement of bulk petroleum products for United States Coast Guard (USCG).

Key Contract Vehicle Features:

- Provides worldwide acquisition and integrated material management of bulk fuel;
- Consolidates and standardizes fuel purchases and product management;
- Provides fuel transaction tracking and reporting through an electronic management system;
- Ensures competitive pricing for bulk fuel;
- Optimizes bulk fuel procurements across DHS; and
- Meets an OMB directive for mandatory bulk fuel purchase.

Period of Performance (POP):

In effect until the termination of DHS MOA or Individual Component IAAs pursuant to the termination provision of the agreement.

Number of Awardees:

One federal government agency
