A recent Congressional Research Service report details the difficulties of collecting I-94 Arrival/Departure forms as visitors leave the country. The report estimated that in 2006, there were between 3.3 million and 6.2 million nonimmigrants overstaying their visas and residing illegally in the U.S., comprising between 31 and 57 percent of the total unauthorized population.
