

DELEGATION TO THE CHIEF PRIVACY OFFICER

I. Purpose

This is a delegation to the Chief Privacy Officer to fulfill responsibilities related to the Freedom of Information Act and Privacy Act programs within the Department.

II. Delegation

Subject to my oversight, direction and guidance, I delegate to the Chief Privacy Officer the authority to develop and oversee the implementation of policies within the Department, and except as otherwise provided by law, carry out the functions of the agency regarding compliance with:

- A. Title 5, United States Code, Section 552, "The Freedom of Information Act," as amended
- B. Title 5, United States Code, Section 552a, "The Privacy Act of 1974," as amended.
- C. Public Law 107-347, Section 208, "E-Government Act of 2002."

III. Re-delegation

The powers, authorities, responsibilities, and functions of the Chief Privacy Officer may be re-delegated in writing to any other appropriate subordinate official.


