**Description:**

Research, study and analyze the networks, supply and value chains, illicit markets, and criminal activities of the transnational criminal networks most hazarding the national security of the homeland. Fuse information about transnational criminals and their associates, organizations and networks from a variety of sources including criminal investigations, law enforcement and homeland security databases, open sources, seized documents, surveillance reports, informants, confidential sources, and court-ordered wiretaps. Assess common or repetitive characteristics of criminal personnel, functions, modus operandi, operations areas and hierarchy. Determine proficiencies and competencies for common criminal positions as well as advancement/promotion paths. Identify common and likely patterns and behavior. Evaluate and summarize this information and provide it to criminal investigators, supervisory JTF-I and DHS personnel, United States Attorneys, and other law enforcement and intelligence agencies as directed. Provide intelligence analysis, research, threat assessments and predictive analysis as part of an analytical team. Develop written products and practical models of criminal networks, supply chains and illicit markets that can be used to identify criminals' vulnerabilities and weaknesses, focus the application of advanced investigative techniques, sensitize interdictors to criminal and anomalous activity, improve the knowledge of DHS leaders, planners, operators and investigators, and enable the deliberate and strategic destruction of targeted networks. Conduct presentations to senior level management on criminal network developments.

Applicants must have a comprehensive understanding of intelligence analysis and targeting. They must have the ability to apply and implement numerous analytical techniques and the willingness to learn to use multiple databases including TECS; FinCEN Portal; Automated Targeting System (ATS); DEA Internet Capability Endeavor (DICE); CCDI; Person Centric Query Service (PCQS); Targeting Frameworks; CBP and USCG databases; and Falcon/Palantir capabilities.

Applicants are required to have solid working experience (3 years minimum) or expertise analyzing criminal networks or supporting criminal investigations. Applicants must have superior oral and written communications skills, and the ability to work independently and/or with a team of other intelligence analysts in an interagency environment to collect information, conduct analysis and develop leads in support of law enforcement cases.
