- Honda Motor Co., Ltd. issued a recall October 13 for 350,000 of its model year 2016 Honda Civic vehicles due to an issue affecting the electric parking brake where the brake may not work if it is applied immediately after turning the ignition off. – *WWJ 62 Detroit; Associated Press* (See item [2](#))

Chemical Industry Sector

1. *October 13, U.S. Department of Labor* – (Louisiana) **OSHA fines Louisiana chemical manufacturer more than \$92K after inspection finds 9 serious violations at Westlake facility.** The Occupational Safety and Health Administration cited PPG Industries for 9 serious and 2 other violations October 11 after an employee complaint prompted an April 2016 investigation at the company's Westlake, Louisiana facility which revealed that the company exposed workers to corrosive materials and a leaking 30,000-gallon hot water tank, failed to inspect safety relief valves, and failed to implement a hazard assessment for confined space entry, among other violations. Proposed penalties total \$92,642.

2. *October 13, WWJ 62 Detroit; Associated Press* – (National) **Honda recalls 350,000 Civic coupes, sedans for brake issue.** Honda Motor Co., Ltd. issued a recall October 13 for around 350,000 of its model year 2016 Honda Civic coupes and sedans sold in the U.S. due to an issue affecting the electric parking brake where the brake may not work if it is applied immediately after turning the ignition off, thereby increasing the risk of injury.

3. *October 13, TheCarConnection.com* – (National) **2016 Kia Optima recalled to fix fractured driveshafts.** Kia Motor Corporation issued a recall October 13 for 12,214 of its model year 2016 Kia Optima sedans equipped with 2.4-liter engines sold in the U.S. due to a faulty right front axle driveshaft that may develop a crack, which can lead to a separation of the shaft, thereby causing a loud noise and a loss of motive power and increasing the risk of a crash.

Financial Services Sector

4. *October 13, U.S. Attorney's Office, Southern District of Florida* – (National) **Former Cay Clubs chief financial officer charged with bank fraud and tax offenses.** The former vice president and chief financial officer of Cay Clubs Resorts and Marinas was charged October 13 for his role in a more than \$28 million scheme where he and a co-conspirator allegedly fraudulently sold the company's units to insiders, using money from the company's bank accounts to finance the cash to close for purchases while obtaining mortgage funding from lending institutions in order to falsely show demand for and inflate the prices of Cay Clubs units from 2004 – 2008. The charges also allege that in 2010 and 2011, the former vice president filed fake individual tax returns for tax years 2004 – 2006, significantly underreporting his income and hiding his receipt of millions of dollars in company earnings.

5. *October 13, Springfield News-Sun* – (Ohio) **Urbana police allege bank employees stole \$391,000.** Two former employees at Urbana Security National Bank in Urbana, Ohio, were indicted the week of October 10 after the duo allegedly embezzled \$391,000 from the bank since 2009.

6. *October 14, Tulsa World* – (Oklahoma) **Two teens killed after car flees trooper, rolls over on U.S. 169 in Tulsa.** Northbound lanes of U.S. Route 169 in Tulsa, Oklahoma, were closed for more than 5 hours October 14 after a vehicle fleeing from police overturned, killing 2 people and injuring 3 others.

7. *October 14, ABC News* – (International) **United Airlines systemwide computer glitch leads to delayed flights, paper tickets, long lines.** United Airlines resolved October 14 an issue with its weight reporting system that caused system wide flight delays for several hours October 13. The airline's Website and mobile app were also temporarily down.

8. *October 13, KGO 7 San Francisco* – (California) **3 injured in big rig accident on SB Hwy 101 in San Jose.** Multiple lanes of southbound Highway 101 in San Jose, California, were closed for more than 5 hours October 13 following a crash involving a semi-truck and another vehicle. Three people were injured.

9. *October 13, KRNV 4 Reno; KRXI 11 Reno* – (Nevada) **Golden Valley Road reopened after crews respond to overturned gravel truck.** An overturned gravel truck prompted the closure of Golden Valley Road in Washoe County, Nevada, for more than 3 hours October 13. No injuries were reported and the cause of the crash remains under investigation.

10. *October 13, KABC 7 Los Angeles* – (California) **1 person killed, 1 arrested after wrong-way crash in Montclair.** Westbound lanes of the 10 Freeway in Montclair, California, were shut down for several hours October 13 after vehicle traveling in the wrong direction struck oncoming traffic. One person was killed and another sustained minor injuries.

11. *October 13, Portsmouth Herald* – (Maine) **Truck overturns on car in 10-vehicle York crash.** Route 1 in York, Maine, was closed for several hours October 13 following a 10-vehicle crash where a dump truck overturned and struck a motorcycle and other vehicles waiting at a traffic light. Four people were transported to an area hospital with injuries.

12. *October 13, KATU 2 Portland* – (Oregon) **Flight to Denver makes emergency landing at PDX shortly after takeoff.** United Airlines Flight 789 en route to Denver International Airport from Portland International Airport in Oregon was forced to turn around and make an emergency landing in Portland October 13 due to reported electrical problems after crew members detected an electrical smell. No injuries were reported.

13. *October 13, U.S. Food and Drug Administration* – (National) **Brownwood Farms issues allergy alert and recall of products based on possible health risk associated with undeclared soy or Yellow #5 food coloring.** Brownwood Farms issued a recall October 7 for roughly 15,000 units of its sauce and condiment products due to mislabeling and undeclared soy or Yellow number 5 food coloring after an employee found that the packaging failed to declare the presence of the allergens. No illnesses have been reported and the products were shipped to distributors and retailers nationwide and sold via the company's Website.

14. *October 13, U.S. Environmental Protection Agency* – (Iowa) **EPA reaches settlement with Agri Star Meat & Poultry, LLC, of Postville, Iowa, for industrial stormwater**

violations. The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) announced October 13 that it reached a \$43,000 administrative settlement with Agri Star Meat & Poultry, LLC, of Postville, Iowa, to resolve industrial storm water violations under the Clean Water Act after a March 2015 investigation found that the company failed to comply with its industrial storm water permit by neglecting to develop and update a sufficient storm water pollution prevention plan, failing to execute best management practices to decrease the amount of storm water pollutants, and neglecting to conduct inspections at its Postville facility, among other violations.

Officials placed five neighboring schools on a soft lockdown as a precaution.

17. *October 13, WTTG 5 Washington, D.C.* – (Virginia) **Tuscarora High School evacuated due to bomb threat; all-clear later given.** Students at Tuscarora High School in Leesburg, Virginia, were evacuated and transported to Heritage High School for the remainder of the day October 13 after the school received a bomb threat. Authorities deemed the area safe after no explosives were found.

18. *October 13, Chattanooga Times Free Press* – (Georgia; Alabama) **Fox Mountain wildfire in Dade County, Ga., spreading into Alabama.** Crews reached 40 percent containment October 13 of the 1,700-acre Fox Mountain Fire burning in Dade County, Georgia, and Alabama.

Information Technology Sector

21. *October 13, SecurityWeek* – (International) **Critical vulnerability patched in Cisco conferencing product.** Cisco reported that its Cisco Meeting Server (CMS) prior to version 2.0.6 and Acano Server prior to versions 1.8.18 and 1.9.6 were plagued with a critical vulnerability affecting the Extensible Messaging and Presence Protocol (XMPP) service that could allow an unauthenticated attacker to access the system as another user if the XMPP is enabled on the affected devices, as the XMPP service incorrectly processes deprecated authentication schemes. The flaw was discovered during a routine security audit of a Cisco customer and there is no evidence the flaw has been exploited in the wild.

CenterPoint Energy crews were monitoring gas levels in the air.
