## Emergency Fuel Supplies and Services

The Department of Homeland Security established an Emergency Fuel Supplies and Services indefinite delivery indefinite quantity (IDIQ) contract vehicle to obtain fuel and fuel related support services during federal emergencies and major disasters within the continental U.S. (CONUS) and outside continental U.S. (OCONUS). Supplies and services available include:

- Procuring, transporting, storing, and dispensing of various fuel types for vehicles (air, land, marine), transportation equipment, support equipment, and generators
- Operating, maintaining, and repairing equipment associated with fuel transportation, dispensing, filtration, and purification
- Providing temporary fuel storage at DHS locations
- Performing fuel quality assurance testing
- Clearing road debris in support of fuel supplies and services delivery

### Key Contract Vehicle Features:

- Provides fuel supplies and services to avoid disruptions during emergencies and minimize the risk of lapses in DHS operations due to lack of fuel;
- Provides emergency fuel supplies and services to meet high volume and fast turn-around requirements;
- Reduces DHS contracting and administrative efforts for fuel acquisition during emergencies and improves DHS's overall fuel logistics contingency management; and
- Ensures competitive pricing by leveraging DHS's volume for required emergency fuel supplies and services.
