NATIONAL INFRASTRUCTURE PROTECTION PLAN REVISION

Starting Point Questions for NIAC Consideration:

- 1) How does the Federal government write a short and clear revised plan that is flexible adaptable, and readable to owners and operators outside of the Beltway?
- 2) What has to be in the plan for it to be seen as useful and applicable to owners and operators?
- 2) How do we incorporate the concepts of how the critical infrastructure mission can operate in a “networked-coordination” environment; but provide enough structure and order that those who are going to be implementing the NIPP can build their own plans, processes, etc.in a measurable way from a national perspective?
- 3) How can the plan focus on critical functions and services (such as the lifeline infrastructures and dependencies by the other sectors) while maintaining appropriate and relevant risk based momentum in the other sectors?
- 4) How can the plan incorporate appropriate support for the 4.8 Million O/O community (baseline) so that they also can benefit from the national programs, capabilities, and lessons learned; that they know what to do and where to go for infrastructure security and resilience information and advice/guidance (given continuous restrained Federal resources)?
