COMMENTS/SUGGESTIONS August 6, 2009

- A more localized version of a threat warning system that included an all-hazards approach would be greatly beneficial.
- Better communication with the states is needed **prior to it going to the national media** when the alert level changes.
- DHS needs to be more specific about what their expectations are from the states when a different level is issued.
- Different aspects, such as aviation facilities, should be able to go to a higher level then the general national level. Further, the levels should also be able to be geographic in nature.
- Moving from a five tier system to a three tier system would make the system more functional.
- There needs to be continued dialogue with the general public, beyond the color-coded system, regarding security and risk.
