# USCIS' Newest Online Form Form I-821, Application for Temporary Protected Status

\*For eligible nationals of Yemen, Syria, Venezuela, Burma, Somalia or Haiti

## Filing Deadlines for TPS

#### **As of August 1, 2021:**

- 18-month registration period for initial applications under TPS designation for **Venezuela now runs through Sept. 9, 2022**.
- 18-month registration period for initial applications under redesignation of **Syria for TPS now runs through Sept. 30, 2022**.
- 18-month registration period for initial applications under TPS designation for **Burma (Myanmar) now runs through Nov. 25, 2022**.
- Yemen initial registration period for individuals who do not currently have TPS: July 9, 2021 March 3, 2023.
- **Somalia** registration period for people who are applying for TPS for the first time: **July 22, 2021 – March 17, 2023**.
- Haiti registration period for people who are applying for TPS for the first time: Aug. 3, 2021 –
   Feb. 3, 2023.



#### I-821, Application For Temporary Protected Status (TPS)

If you are an eligible national of certain countries that the Secretary of Homeland Security (Secretary) has designated for Temporary Protected Status (TPS) or a person without nationality who last habitually resided in the designated country, then you may apply for TPS by filing Form I-821, Application for Temporary Protected Status. This form is also used if you have TPS and are filing for TPS re-registration.

Do not use Form I-821 to request Consideration Of Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals (DACA). Form I-821D must be used to request DACA.





## **Quick Tips**

- Online form is the same as paper version
- Form logic based on your answers, starts at the beginning
- Answer as many questions as you can
- Work at your own pace, we automatically save your answers
- Draft forms are saved for 30 days from the last time you worked on your form

## **Getting Started – Reason for Applying**

#### What is your reason for applying?

 Initial application for Temporary Protected Status (TPS) - applicant has not been previously granted TPS



#### To submit this form online...

- This MUST BE your first TPS application, and
- You MUST BE an eligible national of Yemen, Syria, Venezuela, Burma, Somalia or Haiti, or an individual without nationality who last habitually resided in one of those six countries.
- If you applied for TPS before, or you are not an eligible national of Yemen, Syria, Venezuela, Burma, Somalia or Haiti, or an individual without nationality who last habitually resided in one of those six countries, and you submit this form online, we will deny your case and keep your filing fee.

## **Concurrent Filing**

- You may submit Form I-821
   with Form I-765 online if you want an Employment
   Authorization Document (EAD)
  - 1. Complete Form I-821 first
  - 2. Then complete Form I-765
  - 3. Pay for both forms at the end

- Yes, I am requesting an Employment Authorization Document (EAD), and I am filing form I-765, Application for Employment Authorization, together with my form I-821.




## **Getting Started - Eligibility**

#### Who Can Submit Form I-821 Online?

Initial release of online I-821 is limited to:


- Eligible nationals of Yemen, Syria,
   Venezuela, Burma, Somalia, or Haiti, or individuals without nationality who last habitually resided in one of those six countries
- Eligible individuals who are submitting their FIRST TPS application




All other categories *must submit* a paper form I-821







- Continuous residence in the United States
- Entry into the United States





## **Document Format Requirements**


- Photos: JPEG or PNG
- Documents: JPG, JPEG, PDF, TIF or TIFF
- Foreign language documents must have English translation
- Maximum size: 6 MB per file



A You can file your request online only for certain eligibility categories

If your eligibility category does not appear on the dropdown list, you must file a paper Form I-765. If you submit online and are not eligible for one of the listed categories,

your application may be denied.



## Filling Out the Form - Review and Submit

#### Your fee



Refund Policy: USCIS does not refund fees, regardless of any action we take on your application, petition or request, or how long USCIS takes to reach a decision. By continuing this transaction, you acknowledge that you must submit fees in the exact amount and that you are paying the fees for a government service.

- Review your entries before you pay
- Once you submit payment, you cannot make corrections
- You cannot request to waive your fee online at this time

# Filling Out the Form - Other Information

- Enter your father's first and last name, and your mother's first and last name



## Filling Out the Form - Evidence

#### All Form I-765 applicants must provide:


- 2"x2" passport-style photograph (JPG, JPEG, or PNG)
- I-94 card (both sides), travel document (both sides), or electronic I-94
- Most recent EAD, if you have one (both sides)
- If no EAD, copy of government-issued photo ID
- Proof of identity and nationality





#### I-821, Application for Temporary Protected Status

If you are an eligible national of a designated country, use this form to apply for Temporary Protected Status (TPS). When filing an initial TPS application or re-registering for TPS, you can also request an Employment Authorization Document (EAD) by submitting a completed Form I-765, Request for Employment Authorization, when you file Form I-821.

You may also file your Form I-765 request separately at a later date.

# Checklist of Required Initial Evidence for Form I-765 (for informational purposes only)

Please do not submit this checklist with your Form I-765. It is an optional tool to use as you prepare your form, but does not replace statutory, regulatory, and form instruction requirements. We recommend that you review these requirements before completing and submitting your form. Do not send original documents unless specifically requested in the form instructions or applicable regulations. You may view the form instructions at uscis.gov/i-765.

If you submit any documents (copies or original documents, if requested) in a foreign language, you must include a full English translation along with a certification from the translator verifying that the translation is complete and accurate, and that they are competent to translate from the foreign language to English.

#### Under Temporary Protected Status (TPS) (a)(12) and (c)(19)

#### Did you provide the following?

- This application concurrently filed with Form I-821, Application for Temporary Protected Status, or evidence that we accepted or approved your initial Form I-821
- · Evidence of your nationality and identity
- A copy of the order granting TPS with your Form I-765 (such as a copy of your Form I-821 that the EOIR
  judge or Board of Immigration Appeals (BIA) approved) if an EOIR immigration judge or the BIA granted
  TPS and you are requesting your first EAD or are re-registering for the first time
