Importantly, the Act also requires federal agencies to participate in the activities of voluntary, private sector, consensus standards bodies.

I am very concerned that DHS and its agency components have not regularly participated in the standards development activities of private sector standards bodies developing standards in critical areas that go to the heart of your agency's functions and mission: intrusion detection, access control, video surveillance, and other efforts related to the interoperability of disparate electronic security system components. I believe the active participation of DHS in these private sector standards areas would be a wise use of agency and taxpayer resources.

Also, what plans have been developed or are being developed to promote DHS participation?
