Tactical Communications Equipment & Services II (TacCom II)

The Department of Homeland Security (DHS) established a multiple award, Indefinite Delivery/Indefinite Quantity (IDIQ), Multi-Agency Contract (MAC) to allow DHS and other federal agencies the ability to procure the latest tools and technologies for end-to-end transmission of mission-critical voice and data. This Best-In-Class (BIC) solution features both equipment (radios, infrastructure, and satellite solutions) and services (systems integration, installation, engineering, and operations and maintenance). There are 45 total awards across two technical categories, one for equipment and one for services. There are 37 unique awardees and 23 small businesses.
